


Why is the 85 Cent levy increase needed?

- Increase the base pay from \$35,500 to the recommended \$38,000 for a first year teacher
- Reduce teacher shortage
- Successfully compete against Arkansas's \$50,000 starting salary for first year teachers
- Attract support staff such as secretaries, custodians, maintenance, etc.

If passed, Proposition Teach would give the District a competitive ability to attract and ALSO retain its teachers. The plan is to use revenues generated from the 85 cent levy increase to raise salaries for teachers and support staff.

Each year, the District will re-evaluate the salary schedule along with other operating needs of the District to determine the best way to use this additional revenue.





Official Ballot Language

Shall the Board of Education of the Doniphan R-I School District, Missouri, be authorized to increase the operating tax levy to \$3.6000 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation for the purposes of attracting and retaining quality certified and support staff, maintaining facilities, and meeting additional operating expenses?

(If this proposition is approved, the adjusted operating tax levy of the District is estimated to increase from \$2.7500, currently, to \$3.6000 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation and will be applied to the assessed valuation in Tax Year 2024 and each year thereafter.)



After locating your real estate and/or personal property tax receipts from Ripley or Butler County, take that figure and divide it by 100 and then multiply it by \$0.85. This is the additional tax you will pay each year.



Ex. Assessed Valuation of \$35,166 (\$150,000 market value home and \$20,000 market value cars/trucks) $$35,166 / 100 \times $0.85 = $298.91 \text{ per year increase}$
